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Health and Safety Policy

1. Introduction:

The policy of "The Crossings" is to provide and maintain as far as is reasonably practical, safe and healthy working conditions. "The Crossings" aims to provide safe equipment and systems of work for both Guests and Volunteers. "The Crossings" Waterside Management group aim to provide such information, training and support as required, for this purpose.

2. Objectives:

"The Crossings" undertakes:

- To provide a working environment that is healthy and safe with satisfactory amenities.
- To ensure that health and safety legislation, regulations and codes of practice are observed.
- To provide and maintain safe premises and equipment including appropriate protective clothing (where appropriate).
- To ensure that the use, handling, storage and transportation of food, articles and substances are safe.
- To ensure that the systems of work are safe and provide or locate appropriate training and advice for volunteers in these matters.
- To ensure that all Guests and Volunteers using the premises are safe and without risk to their health.
- To review and revise this policy annually or as new legislation requires.

3. Communication:

Guests will be advised of this policy upon request.

Volunteers will be informed of the policy at briefing meetings and details will be included in the Volunteers Handbook.

If anyone is excluded from the Project as a result of breaching the policy, all team members will be informed by entry in the log sheet and the matter referred to the Project Leader who, in turn, will report the matter to the next meeting of "The Crossings" management group.
